- ➤ Evidence of National Identification Number Registration with NIMC by minimum of two (2) Company Directors who are Nigerians.
- > Tax Identification Number.
- Company's Current Three (3) Years Audited Account duly signed. (2017, 2018 & 2019).

- Verifiable Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance certificate (2019).
- ➤ Verifiable current PENCOM Compliance Certificate.
- Evidence of Successful Conduct of Similar Projects in the Past, not later than five (5) years from date of quote.
- Sworn affidavit indicating that Company is not in Receivership nor any of its Directors involved or convicted of any fraudulent activity.
- Accompanying sworn affidavit of disclosure; to disclose clearly if any of the officers (or related persons) of the National Identity Management Commission (NIMC) or the Bureau for Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present Director of the company.
- A sworn affidavit that the Company is not a replacement for a hitherto Tax defaulting Company.
- > Evidence of Financial Capability and Banking Support.
- ➤ Verifiable current certificate of Interim Registration Report (IRR) with Bureau of Public Procurement showing registration on National Database of Contractors, Consultants & Service providers.
- For Joint Venture (JVS), include the memorandum of understanding (MOU).
- Verifiable current NSITF Compliance Certificate (2019).

i. Original Documents should be available for sighting on demand.

Submission Details

- 1. The vendor is required to submit 2 (two) copies of its response in sealed envelopes; the envelope containing the eligibility documents should be sealed & labelled "DOCUMENT"; the envelope containing quotes should be labelled "FINANCIALS" & must be separated. The Reference (EMV DEVICES) must be written boldly in the right hand corner of the envelopes.
