Governor Ganduje Declares 60 Days of Emergency Enrolment In Kano

The Governor of Kano State, Dr. Abdullah Ganduje has flagged off 60 days of emergency enrollment of citizens and legal residents into the National Identity Database and Voters Card registration in Kano State.

Governor Ganduje in his remarks highlighted the importance of the NIN to the socio-economic development of the state and in eliminating identity fraud, ghost workers and other crimes in the State and country.

He also reiterated the support the state government has been providing to NIMC such as V-sat, solar panels, inverters and annual subscription fee and other relevant tools to all the 44 local government offices in the state.

Engr. Aliyu Aziz in his remarks affirmed NIMC's mandate "We are focused on giving Nigeria a world class identity management infrastructure, which will be pivotal to the security and socio-economic transformation of the country."

He also assured NIMC's commitment to delivering a sustainable world class identity ecosystem for Nigeria with the commencement of the new Identity Ecosystem "Data gathering and collection will no longer be by NIMC alone rather all the data capturing agencies in the federal, state, local government levels and other private sectors." He said.
