## NIMC Deploys State of The Art Mobile Enrolment Kits to Kano State

In continuing the collaboration between Kano State Government and National Identity Management Commission to massively enroll Kano states residents into the National Identity Database (NDIB) in 60 days, the DG/CEO NIMC, Engr. Aliyu Aziz ordered the relocation of GM Operations, Abdulhamid Umar and DGM ESNI, Elias Okafor to ensure the success of the program.

It can be recalled that the Collaboration yielded a Memorandum of Understanding that demanded NIMC to Support the Kano State Government in the 60 days State of Emergency declared for enrollment of Residents in the State into the NIDB, a view to making the NIN mandatory for Civil servants and for accessing Government services in Kano state.

To achieve this, 20 state of the art mobile enrollment kits, first of its kind in Africa were deployed to Kano State and activated to complement the existing equipment's and infrastructure. To ensure proper use of these new systems, NIMC Staff From the State were trained and tested to ensure competency in the use of the systems.

To further give credence to the process, a courtesy call was made to the Secretary to the Kano State Government, Alhaji Usman Alhaji by the NIMC delegation led by GM Operations, Adulhamid Umar including DGM ESNI, Elias Okafor, NW Regional Coordinator, Hajjiya Bilkiisu



Dalhat Isma, Kano state Coordinator Engr. Sanusi Muhammad and two Principal Managers.

The team expressed gratitude to the State Government for the historical support the State has always rendered to NIMC and also requested the State Government's support in procuring additional enrollment kits to supplement the 20 deployed by NIMC, recruit additional ad-hoc staff to address issues of personal to manage enrollment systems, provide uninterrupted power supply and other equipment that will ensure the success of the project in all the 44 Local Government areas swiftly.

In his response, Alhaji Usman reiterated the Governors excitement on the collaboration which borne the setting up of a committee comprising of the Commissioner of Local Government Affairs and the Commissioner for Information amongst others to liaise with all the 44 LGA Chairmen to ensure NIMC is provided with logistics and support desired in delivering enrollment throughout the State. He also promised to escalate all issues and requests to the Governor on his return.

It should be noted that up until the Collaboration, Kano state was recorded between 600 to 1000 enrollments per week, with the collaboration Kano state enrolls up to 20,000 residents in a week. This shows that the process has been accepted and embraced by the people of Kano.
