The National Identity Management Commission (NIMC) held a Pre-Bid Conference at the International Conference Center Abuja on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2019, to sensitize prospective licensees for the Digital Identity Ecosystem on procedures for the Expression of Interest submissions.

The Director General/CEO Engr. Aliyu A. Aziz in his opening remarks emphasized the importance of Identity for all as it can be seen in the Sustainable Development goal 16.9 (providing legal identity for all including birth registration by 2030), but so far 38 million Nigerians out of the country's population of about 200 million have been captured in

the National Identity Database.

Engr. Aziz also reiterated the need for collaboration and support between NIMC and the private sector in ensuring that Nigerians and Legal Residents have proper identification, as having a robust and reliable National Identity Database is needed for socio-economic planning and even distribution of resources.
