CROSS SECTION OF SOME NIMC MANAGEMENT STAFF AT THE PRESENTATION OF THE 2020 BUDGET

The National Identity Management Commission (NIMC) has presented its proposed 2020 budget and defended its 2019 budget performance before the Senate Committee on National Identity and National Population Commission.

Committee chaired by Senator Saidu Alkali, the DG/CEO Engr. Aliyu A. Aziz who was represented by the General Manager, Legal Regulatory Compliance and Services (LRC&S), Hadiza A. Dagabana stated that "the appropriated capital of ₹652, 050, 00.00 was yet to be released as at September 2019 while overhead released was №165, 400,160.00 as against the appropriated sum of №392, 760,383.00."

"We made a case with the Office the Database. of the Secretary to the Govern-

ment of the Federation (OSGF) that the appropriated capital is inadequate, taking into cognizance that the NIMC is the primary repository of biometric and demographic data of Nigerians and Legal Residents. As such it is heavily dependent on Information Technology and must ensure ample maintenance of infrastructure, safeguard the National Identity Database (NIDB) making sure it is secured at all times," she lamented.

Dagabana added that the introduction of the Digital Identity Ecosystem to be funded by the World Bank, Agence Française de Développement (AFD) and the Europe-Presenting the budget before the an Union (EU) would help populate the NIDB when licenses are issued to Public Private Partners coming on

> Responding to the presentation made by the GM, LRC&S, the Co-Chairman of the Committee Senator Suleiman A. Kwari sympathized with the Commission and most importantly commended the unrelenting efforts made by NIMC in making sure that more Nigerians and Legal Residents are captured into

"National Identification Number (NIN) is curbing crimes and other data collection agencies should key into the NIMC identity infrastructure by harmonizing data to render seamless services to Nigerians," he

The Chairman of Committee in his closing remarks assured the Commission that once the 2020 budget is passed, the Committee will ensure funds are released to avail the Commission carry out its man-

He further wished the Commission well and cited that the Committee will be divided into groups for effective supervision of the Commission and its state offices to ensure that all hands are on deck and carrying out their duties according to their constitutional responsibili-

The proposed 2020 budget is summed up to \$6,104,839,429.00 consisting of Personnel, Overhead and Capital.
