## Nigerians in Diaspora can now enrol into the National Identity Database (NIDB)

On the 6th March, 2019, the National Identity Management Commission (NIMC), kept to her promise to extend the National Identity Management Scheme (NIMS) to Nigerians in Diaspora. This will ensure that all Nigerians in the Diaspora are enrolled into the National Identity Database and issued the National Identification Number (NIN) at a cost.
