NIMC Management Solve Mobility Challenge in the Headquarters.

As part of efforts aimed at ameliorating the challenges faced by physically challenged, the NIMC management has made provisions for stress-free mobility within and around it premises in the Headquarters.

Principal Manager, Software Development- Mr Sola Amurawaiye who disclosed this in an interview with the Corporate Communications media team, commended the NIMC management for the transformation in the Commission in this regard.

He said, "In the past, we had a small ramp at the Headquarters, but there is a reform for people with mobility challenge, as they can now move around the Commission with little or no stress. This is highly commend-

able and is a very big step moving forward".

Mr. Amurawaiye added that this new development is in line with the ongoing trend in other government agencies, where people with disabilities are included in all facets of life.



"The Commission can take this trend to a higher level by providing enhanced technology as well as individuals that can communicate in sign languages to people with hearing disability and guide those who are visually impaired. As it will enable the Commission to reach all Nigerians, irrespective of their level or type of disability".

He further recommended that, the management can engage staff members of the Commission especially in the Human Capital

Management (HCM) to organise trainings that will sensitize, enlighten and educate other staff in the Commission to understand requisite information that will expose them to accommodate persons with special needs amongst staff and customers who come for enrolment.

"A person with disability working in the Commission also has something to contribute to the work force, he or she should be related with and should not experience any form of discrimination or bias" he said.

He thanked the DG/CEO and other management staff for recognising people with disabilities and hopes that the NIMC workforce becomes more integrated and inclusive for other people with disability in the headquarters and its state offices.
